Resilience Networks (Kingston - 11 - 19 years)

Introduction

The Resilience Network meetings offer support and guidance to partner agencies in the provision of Early Help to Children and Families. The resilience networks will begin in January 2021 and the desired outcome is to deliver early help, by the best person at the earliest possible opportunity.

The aim of this network is for your organisation to be able to share and reflect on a case to a panel of professionals and develop a plan for the family in line with the Signs of Safety model. If you are not familiar with Signs of Safety the eLearning: Signs of Safety Briefing is available and can be booked on CPD Online. Practitioners can also book on to future sessions if at any time they would like to revisit a case they have already shared.

The Resilience Networks will take place in Kingston and Richmond and be arranged into age groups. Please ensure that you book on to the correct session for the age range of the children that you are working with.

Networks will take place monthly and will be facilitated via google meets. A joining link will be emailed 24 hours prior to the start date.
