Fire Safety Awareness - with use of extinguishers

Introduction

Due to the serious nature and the potential devastating consequences of fire, it is vital that all workers are aware of what to do if they discover a fire. This 3-hour course is designed for all staff regardless of role. It will cover workplace fire safety topics that are needed to ensure the safety of the employee and their fellow staff members. The course will help any member of staff to better understand the crucial information which can be so valuable in the case of a fire.

This training is suitable for Workplace Fire Marshals and instruction also satisfies the requirements laid down in the Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) order 2005.

Learning Outcomes

At the end of the course the participants will be able to:

• Recognise how fires start and how quickly they can spread.

• Demonstrate a general awareness of the importance of fire doors, good housekeeping and how to raise concerns with line managers.

• Identify types of fire extinguisher and be able to use an extinguisher on a fire if required in an emergency.
