



## Basic Life Support for School Nurses and Health Visitors

### Introduction

Rapid response to emergency situations can save lives. Survival rates for an unconscious individual are increased by up to 60 percent through prompt resuscitation.

The Basic Life Support course covers Adult and paediatric Life support including Anaphylaxis. Its aim is at health care professionals who care for patients. It is in accordance to the Resuscitation Council (UK) and is required for nurse's revalidation.

This course is specifically commissioned for Health Visitors and Schools nurses who work for Achieving for children in the Royal Borough of Windsor and Maidenhead as part of their annual revalidation requirements

The session will be informative and interactive providing all staff with the essential information and practical knowledge of dealing with common but life threatening conditions. Participants will leave the session feeling more confident in dealing with first aid emergencies.

### Learning Outcomes

By the end of the session delegates will be able to:

- Demonstrate how to perform basic life support using the CPR mask on the Adult, child and infant manikins.
- Demonstrate the recovery position.
- Demonstrate choking manoeuvres and all three manikins.
- Use the auto-injectors safely when treating anaphylaxis
