



Introduction to Childminding

Introduction

'Home-based childcare provides children and their families with a home-from-home childcare environment, which for the parents enables them to build up a friendly rapport with their child's caregiver, and the process of walking into someone's home, instantly puts you at ease, making the parent as well as the child feel comfortable.' (Kathy Brodie, 2019)

Introduction to Childminding will introduce the learner to working as a home based child carer such as a childminder or a nanny. This course will support learners to develop policies and procedures that are required for Ofsted registration which will reflect current legislation requirements, including the Early Years Foundation Stage. It will enable the learner to develop the common core skills and the basic business skills that they will need to set up and maintain a successful home based child care service.
